Ph.D Admission Test (PAT)-2023

(As per common ordinance & regulation approved by the Governor's Secretariat, Bihar vide Memo No.BSU-05/2010/2864/GS (I) dtd.21.09.2017 & Letter No. BSU (Regulation)-05/2010/3230/GS (I) dtd.18.12.2018).

Candidates having Master's degree with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC-7 point scale (or an equivalent grade as applicable in a point scale wherever grading system is followed), and a relaxation of 5% marks from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, will be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/EBC/BC/EWS/Differently-abled Categories may apply for PAT-2023 through online link available on university website-<https://www.mungeruniversity.ac.in> upto 15th March 2023.

1. PAT will be conducted in following subjects :-

- Faculty of Science- Botany, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics & Zoology.
- Faculty of Social Sciences- History, Political Science, Geography, Economics, Sociology, Psychology, Home Science, Music.
- Faculty of Humanities- Hindi, English, Sanskrit, Urdu, Philosophy, Bangla.
- Faculty of Commerce- Commerce.

Note –

- The Subject wise vacancy will be announced later on.
- In case of allied disciplines/ interdisciplinary subjects, the Departmental Research Committee (DRC) of the respective department/s would be taking an appropriate decision which would be binding on the candidate.

Eligibility for PAT-2023:-

- Candidates having Master's degree with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC-7 point scale (or an equivalent grade as applicable in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- A relaxation of 5% marks, i.e. from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, will be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/EBC/BC/EWS/Different abled categories of candidates.
- A candidate shall ordinarily be permitted to pursue research for the Ph.D. Degree in the subject in which he/she holds Master's Degree.

Exemption from the written test of PAT-2023

- Candidates who have secured grants for research such as fellowship/Scholarship/associate ship etc. by qualifying UGC-NET/CISR-NET/GATE/MHRD Scholarships/Teacher fellowship/DBT/ICMR/ICAR/DST-INSPIRE/CISR, ICHR etc.
- Assistant professor, Associate professor and Professor who has been appointed on substantive post in the UGC Pay scale in the Teaching Department/Constituent College of the University who have completed their probation successfully with an experience of at least two

years of uninterrupted service would be considered under this category. Teachers appointed in self finance courses will not be exempted from the Test.

c) Non-teaching employee of the University, who are holding substantive appointment for more than five years and having at least 55% marks in Master's degree in the subjects concerned and with at least two research papers published in any reputed refereed journal or Journals indentified by the UGC would be considered under this category.

- Candidates exempted from PAT-2023 are also required to apply online with requisite fee. They will have to appear directly before interview board.

3. Procedure for Ph.D. Admission Test (PAT)-2023

PAT is written test comprising two papers of 100 marks each. Paper-I will consist of multiple choice questions on qualitative, teaching and research aptitude. The paper-II will be subjective type in the subject concerned based on syllabus of the Post Graduate Courses of the Munger University.

Paper-I

No. of MCQ Questions – 50 (of 02 marks each)

Full Marks – $2 \times 50 = 100$

Duration of Examination – 01 Hour.

There will be no Negative Marking.

B	60	Total '10' Questions. Out of which '6' are to be answered. Each question contains 10 marks.

The minimum qualifying marks for written test will be as follows:-

For UR Candidates: 50% Aggregate marks.

For Reserved Category Candidates: 45% Aggregate marks.

The subject wise merit list will be prepared with a weightage on PAT/NET/BET/SLET/JRF and interview.
